Dear Mr. Alley,

I refer to your email and application dated 15th October 2021 in connection with the above matter.

Your application in relation to the proposed PLASTIC2WAXLIFE project has been assessed. I am pleased to confirm that the Minister has issued approval-in-principle for the allocation of funds from the Climate Action Fund to provide co-financing for this project of up to a maximum of €1.5m or 30% of the total eligible costs (**whichever is lower**), subject to:

- a successful outcome in the LIFE 2021 call;
- the development of a grant funding agreement with this Department; and
- compliance with any State aid requirements.

Further information will be required to determine the exact position regarding State aid in relation to the co-financing of this project. It is proposed that this matter is further examined in the event that you are successful in securing LIFE funding for this project and when all eligible costs are known. In the meantime, it is important to note that the funds approved-in-principle above may be reduced in line with relevant State aid intensities, should they be considered to apply in your particular case.
